Thanksgiving Pet Safety Tips



Thanksgiving is full of delicious food and celebration, but some holiday favorites can be dangerous for pets. Keep these tips in mind:

Skip the table scraps

Turkey bones, gravy, onions, garlic, grapes, and chocolate can cause serious health issues.

Offer safe treats

Plain turkey (no skin or seasoning), carrots, green beans, or a spoonful of pumpkin purée are great pet-friendly alternatives.

With a little preparation, your pets can enjoy a safe and happy Thanksgiving right alongside the family!



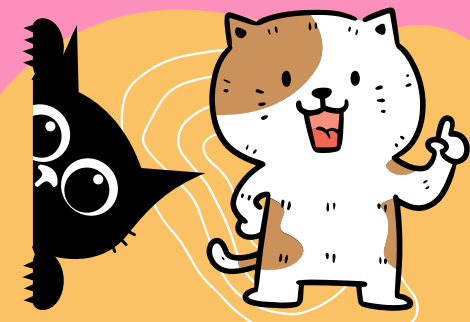
MEET OUR PET SITTERS

Inclement Weather Policy

WINTER WEATHER & DOG WALKS

On extremely cold days - generally when the “feels like” temperature is 32°F or below by midday - all walks will be shortened for the safety of your dog and our pet sitters. Walks will be “business only,” usually no more than 10 minutes, just long enough for your pup to relieve themselves. The remainder of the visit will take place indoors.

If you prefer, you can shorten your visit time to 20 minutes (instead of your normal walk length) on the coldest winter days. Please contact us with any questions or special requests regarding this policy.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CLOSURE & HAZARDOUS TRAVEL



All Friends Pet Care follows the Federal Government’s inclement weather closures.

- If the Federal Government closes due to weather, all midday dog walks will be cancelled.
- If the Federal Government remains open but road conditions are hazardous, our sitters will use their best judgment to determine which clients can be safely reached.

Please note: Our pet sitters primarily travel via back roads and side streets, which are often the most hazardous during winter weather. Sitters will notify clients as soon as a decision regarding travel ability has been made.
