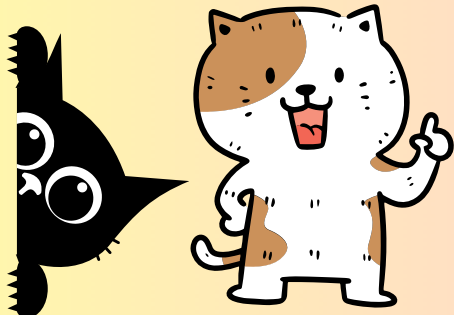




MEET OUR PET SITTERS

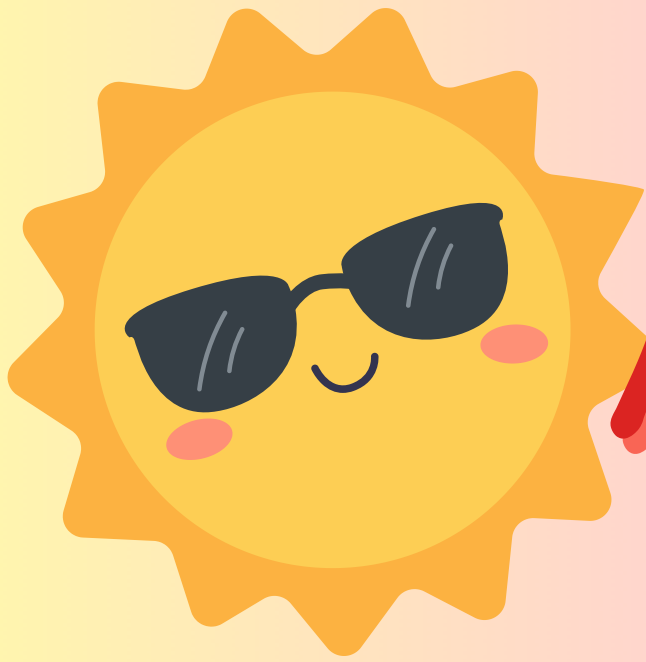

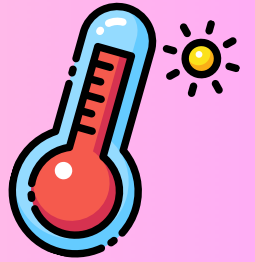

HEAT ADVISORY



Hot weather dog walking policy

On any day when there is an extreme heat warning from the National Weather Service, usually defined as a heat index or "feel like" temperature of 92 degrees or above by noon, **all walks will be shortened for the safety of your dog as well as our pet sitters.** Walks will be "business only", usually no more than 10 minutes, taking it slowly and sticking to the shady areas where possible, with the balance of the visit time spent indoors. Let us know if you have any questions about this policy, or if you'd like to shorten your visit time to 20 minutes (if you normally pay for a longer walk) on any of the heat warning days.

We have instructed our sitters to take it slow and easy on all of their walks, sticking to grass and sidewalks. And if they must travel on road pavement, make it quick! One tip we learned long ago: take the back of your hand and hold it to the pavement. If you can't keep it there for at least five seconds before having to pull away, the ground is **TOO HOT** for your pup's paws! We have told sitters to shorten any walk where they don't have access to shade or cooler areas. Walks should be business-only in those cases but keep in mind: the full visit time is still to be spent with the dog! As the client, you may choose to shorten visits on these hot days - please let us know any visit times that need to be adjusted so we can make sure you are charged correctly.
